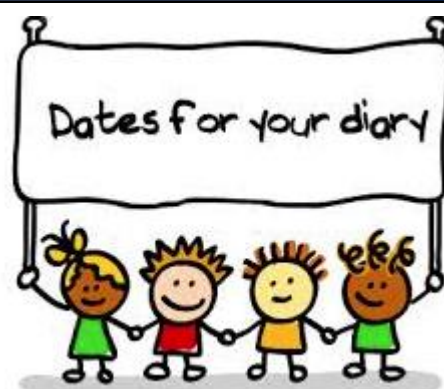

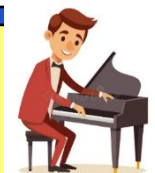

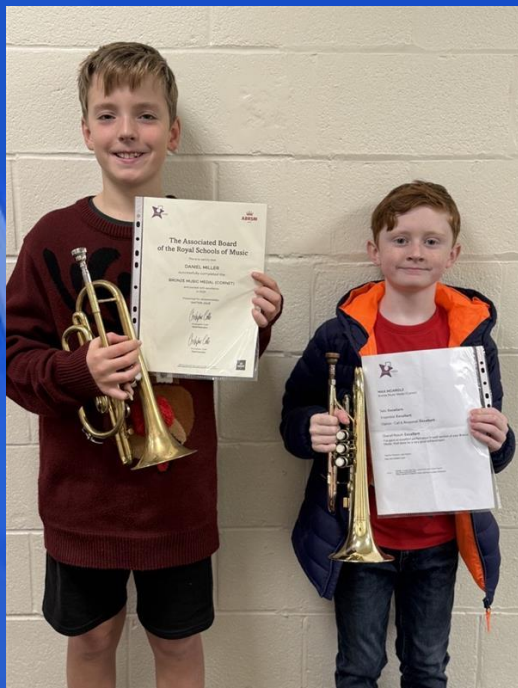
Well done, Joshua. We are very proud of you!
