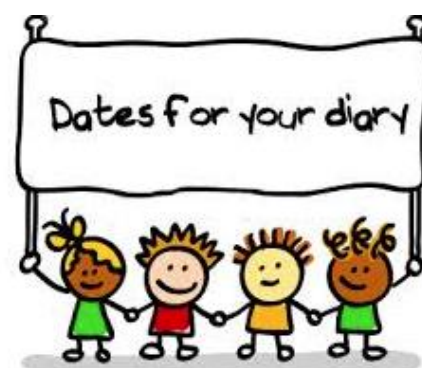

It was brilliant to see everyone giving their best and demonstrating just how much progress you've made. We can't wait to see you continue to grow on your Taekwondo journey!

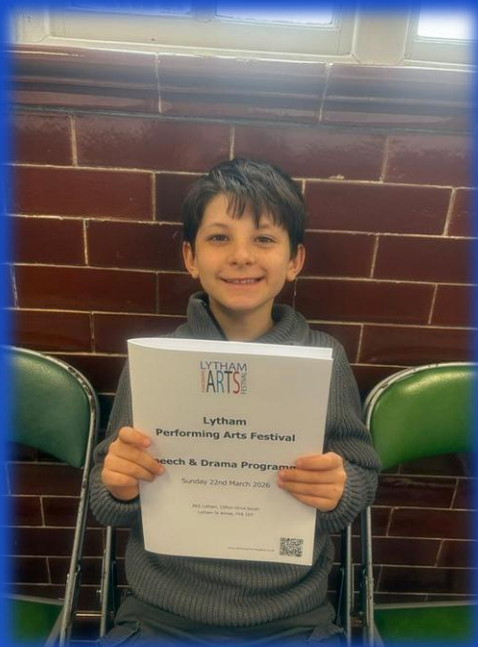

### A Crucial Update on School Parking & Road Safety

We understand that the morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up can be one of the most stressful parts of the day. However, we have reached a point where we must address ongoing concerns regarding parking and conduct around the school gates.

#### Respecting Our Neighbors

We are continuing to receive a high volume of complaints from local residents. Common issues include:

- **Blocked Driveways:** Even "just for a minute" prevents our neighbours from getting to work or appointments.
- **Pavement Parking:** This forces parents with prams, wheelchairs and young children into the road.
- **Idling Engines:** To keep our air clean for the students, please turn off your engines while waiting.

#### A Note on Conduct: Supporting our PCSO

Most importantly, we have been saddened to hear reports that our local Police Community Support Officer (PCSO) has been subjected to verbal abuse from some members of our school community while trying to manage traffic safety.

**Our Stance:** We maintain a zero-tolerance policy regarding abuse toward school staff or community partners. Our PCSOs are here to ensure your children can cross the road safely. Please model the kindness and respect we expect from our students when interacting with them.

#### How You Can Help

If the area is congested, please consider the "Park and Stride" approach: park a few streets away where there is more space and enjoy a short 5-minute walk to the gates. This significantly reduces the bottleneck directly outside the school and keeps our children much safer.

Thank you to the vast majority of our families who continue to park safely, legally, and treat our neighbors and officers with the respect they deserve.
