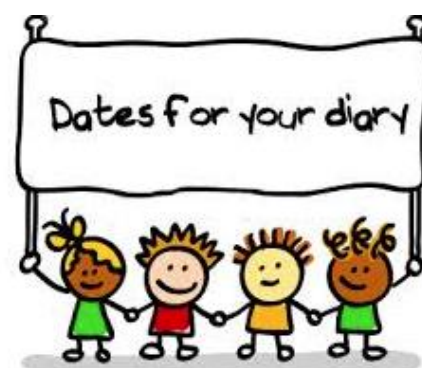

Road Safety

A message from our Junior Road Safety Ambassadors -

A couple of weeks ago, we launched a competition to promote safer parking around school. We asked pupils to create a poster to highlight areas where there should be NO PARKING at school drop-off and pick-up times. These areas include double yellow lines, zig-zag lines in front of the school, in front of driveways, on curbs, pavements and bends and on our neighbours' lawns.

The best 15 posters will be selected to create a large banner to be on display at the front of the school, for all to see, so posters need to have a clear message, bold (but not too much) writing and be bright and colourful enough to stand out at a distance.

IMPORTANT MESSAGE

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to address a situation that has now become a significant daily demand on my time as Headteacher.

Every day, I am required to manage an overwhelming volume of complaints from our neighbours regarding unsafe parking and a lack of respect for private property. This is unsustainable and diverts my focus from the education and leadership of the school.

Specific daily reports include:

- **Dangerous Parking:** Cars blocking driveways and double-parking, creating lethal blind spots for our children.
- **Trespassing:** Children entering private gardens and flowerbeds.
- **Invasion of Privacy:** Residents reporting both children and adults looking into their windows.

As a school family, we must be better neighbours. I am asking you to park legally—even if it requires a longer walk—and to supervise your children closely until they enter the gates.

I value your support, but this daily cycle of complaints must end immediately for the sake of our community relationships and, most importantly, our pupils' safety.
